EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Greetings members,

Last month we started up a lot of our programming and services under some new COVID-19 restrictions. We have implemented the "Restriction Exemption Program" (REP) at Nord-Bridge, this allows us to continue as 'business as usual' with some restrictions still in place. If we did not implement the REP we would be forced to shut down our dining room, all fitness programs, all social activities and most support services. By following the REP we are screening everyone who comes into Nord-Bridge for Proof of Vaccination or proof of medical exemption and or a negative rapid test.

If someone does not have proof of vaccination at the door, we try to accommodate and look up their vaccine record (Alberta Health Care Card and the month that the person received their vaccination will be required). If we are unable to retrieve the vaccine record the person will not be allowed entry into Nord-Bridge.

I would like to thank all the members and people in the community that have been supportive of Nord-Bridge implementing this program. This has enabled us to continue with our day to day business and operate almost 90% of our programs and services (with some masking and physical distancing guidelines still in effect).

This month eligible voting residents of Lethbridge will head to the polls on October 18th for our Municipal Election. Last month we hosted our Meet and Greet for all 38



candidates (6 mayoral and 32 councillor). We had an amazing turnout with over 150 members of the community come and meet 34 of the candidates (4 were unable to attend). If you were unable to attend the Meet and Greet, many of the candidates have provided literature on our elections table by the Berlando Boardroom. I encourage you to exercise your democratic privilege and vote for those you feel best committed and capable of governing our community.

Our General Membership Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, November 3rd at 9:30 a.m. in the Multi-Purpose Hall. Please note Carpet Bowling and Line Dancing will be cancelled on this day.

Join me in congratulating Terry Toth the new owner of the Medicine Shoppe Pharmacy located at Nord-Bridge. Terry has worked the last seven years at the Medicine Shoppe; prior to that he was the manager at the North Safeway pharmacy location for 16 years. Terry has enjoyed being a small part of the Nord-Bridge family over the last few years and has appreciated the support of the clients, some of who he has known for more than 20 years. Terry and Nord-Bridge would like to thank Chad and Louisa Baker for the 10+ years they owned and operated the store. Terry will continue to offer the same high standard of care and welcomes all to come by the pharmacy for any health services or just to say hi and see what they have to offer.


Change is not a bad thing though.
