PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Where did 2021 go? December already. It seems like I just submitted my newsletter write up last week for November. November was great for us as we attended many of the special meals here at Nord-Bridge and things are picking up in all areas. The dining room especially is getting busy and it so great to see the parking lot full again.



Our General Membership meeting was attended by 63 members which is the largest

On November 12, 2021, the Galt Museum hosted an evening of storytelling exploring the rich history of broadcasting in Southern Alberta. Bob Johnson, Brent Seely, Quinn Campbell, and Mark Campbell shared many fascinating stories of their years working in television. I was especially interested in attending this event because broadcasting is the reason we live in Lethbridge. Bob Johnson managed the station when I worked at CJLH Channel 7 from 1969 to 1971 as a broadcast engineer. CJLH TV went on the air in 1955, CHCT in Calgary started broadcasting in 1954. My dad was a farmer in Nanton, and he bought one of the first TV sets in Nanton. Dad put the antenna in the attic of our farmhouse so no one would know we had a TV. I started watching the test pattern before they even started programing, so I guess I have always been a TV fanatic. From 1967 to 1969, I took Electronics and Broadcasting at SAIT in Calgary and then applied to work at the Calgary station, CHCT. When I went to the interview in Calgary I found out the job was in Lethbridge and it paid \$300 a month. I got the job and started in April of 1969. I asked how do I find the station and they told me "Just look it up, you can't miss the

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

atmosphere. We have over 20 trees decorated in the rooms and hallway, lights and garland strung along the ledges and Christmas songs playing throughout the building. Thank you to all the staff and volunteers who helped set-up and decorate!

Last month, we welcomed a new employee to our team here at Nord-Bridge. Charlene Kocken is our new Seniors System Navigator. Many of you have already popped your head into her office to give her a friendly warm Nord-Bridge welcome. Charlene has been a fantastic addition and brings a wealth of experience and knowledge to our team. If you haven't met her yet, stop in to say hi if her office door is open.

Please note; our Board of Directors are discussing options of what will be done with the former KFC property and we hope to have details to share with our membership sometime in 2022. your proof of double vaccination and wear a mask. These items and some of the beautiful Christmas trees will be donated to those less fortunate.


