NORD-BRIDGE 2022 AGM & BOARD ELECTION Wednesday, March 2, 2022, 9:30 a.m. Nominations Notice for Board & Executive Positions

At the Association's upcoming Annual General Meeting, scheduled for **March 2, 2022, 9:30 am**, the membership of Nord-Bridge will be asked to elect a new Executive. This occurs annually. Executive Officers can serve a maximum of 3 years in the same position, excepting for the Treasurer and Board Secretary, who can be elected for extended terms. In 2022 our membership will minimally elect (or re-elect) the President and Vice-President. Members will also be asked to vote on the Treasurer and Board Secretary. The By-Laws outline that [where possible] nominations for Executive positions are made from individuals who have served on the most recent Board, and have been a Director on the Board for a period of at least one year.

In addition, at least 3 Directors are elected to the Board annually. Directors on the Board are elected from members of the Society in "good standing", per By-Law Item 7.1.4. Directors can serve up to two terms of 3 years each.

If you would like to serve on the Executive or Board of Directors, please see the By-Laws in the Library or at the Front Reception Desk; or speak with a member of the Nominations Committee, chaired by Past-President Pat Santa; or with Executive Director David Ng. You might also wish to speak with a current member of the Board to learn of their du-



ties and experiences. Nomination Forms are available at the Front Reception Desk as of January 10th with nominations being accepted at the Front Reception desk until 4:30 pm on Monday, February 14, 2021.

Executive Director's Report

I'm going to take this months Newsletter to highlight and recognize two valued board members who will be wrapping up their term on our board at this months AGM. Mr. Clay Olsen and Mr. Jim Hahn have served a collective 33 years on our Board of Directors. Clay joined our Board in 2002 shortly after we moved into our current building from the Bill Kergan



Centre. Within one year, Clay took on the role of Vice President and held the role for three years. In 2006, Clay became the 12th President of Nord-Bridge and was instrumental in the purchases of two shuttle buses for our Go Friendly Shuttle Program. One shuttle for the partnership with the City of Lethbridge and the other shuttle for Nord-Bridge's travel programs. After his three year term as president Clay served 3 more years as the past President. From 2013 to present day; Clay served 8 more years on the board. On top of volunteer leadership Clay provided to Nord-Bridge; he is also our resident jack of all trades. Fixing the odd thing here and there like tables, squeaky doors, leaks and lights were tasks that Clay took on throughout the day. Clay, also took on the role of opening our doors in the morning for many years; as well as taking on volunteers duties such as shuttle bus driving, bingo caller and convener for numerous activities such as floor curling, shuffleboard and carpet bowling. Jim Hahn, started on the Board of Directors in 2007 and served as board member for three years until he ascended to the Vice President role for another three year term starting in 2010. In 2013, Jim became the 14th President of Nord-Bridge and served for three years and concluded another three years as our past president. After a brief one year hiatus from the Board of Directors as per our bylaws Jim returned to serve one three year term; totalling 15 years of volunteering on our board. During Jim's tenure on the board, our volunteer and fundraising portfolio reached new heights. Jim planned entertainment fundraisers such as Old Favorites and Sqt. Wilson's Army Show that generated significant fundraising revenues. During Jim's Presidency, Nord-Bridge was successful in hosting the Grey Matters Conference in 2013 (a conference that was generally hosted in Edmonton or Calgary). Jim was also instrumental in organizing annual events such as the Presidents Dinner and the Annual Miners Banquet that honoured miners in our community. Jim networked and created partnerships with many local businesses that sponsored many of the fundraising events that Jim had programmed. Jim also volunteered every Monday running our 50/50 during our Jam Sessions.

Both Clay and Jim's commitment to volunteering extended outside of Nord-Bridge as Clay was an active Board member of Zone 1 - Sunny South Sports and Recreation Association and Jim was the Director of Volunteers on the Board of Directors for the 2009 Alberta 55 Plus Winter Games. Unofficially, these two men have contributed about 20,000+ volunteer hours to Nord-Bridge and to the community. Please join me in thanking these fine gentlemen for the selfless dedication to Nord-Bridge. I appreciate the leadership and support they

have given to me in my position as the E.D. for Nord-Bridge and sincerely thank them for all their time and dedication.



We discuss dealing with guilt and grief, managing stress, improving communication, navigating the system and planning for the journey ahead.




