EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Greetings Members;


In previous Newsletters, I have told Nord-Bridge about our Centre's involvement in the Alberta Association of Seniors Centres. This group of senior serving organizations was formed in 2011. and Nord-Bridge is proud to be "one of the five founding member organizations". AASC has slowly grown, and in 2016 we had 27 member Centres. The



groups purpose is to work on networking and advocacy on behalf of the nearly 400 seniors centres and senior serving organizations, both large and small, across Alberta. I serve as Treasurer of AASC, and both Tracy and I have regular involvements with the society. Currently AASC has a contract with the Government of Alberta, to conduct through an approved team of consultants, a study known as PISCS (the Provincial Integrated Seniors Centre System) study. It will help define the roles of seniors centres, and recommend to government if, and how they should be funded as part of the health and wellness support system of Alberta. As of last week, some 80 seniors centres have contributed to the PISCS system study. Hopefully, the study will lead to a more rationalized, and dedicated funding system for Nord-Bridge, and other Centres meeting provincial criteria. One of the other benefits from our involvement in AASC, has been critical networking with other centres represented on AASC's Board. For example, the City of Edmonton recently published, and discussed at their Council, two (2) reports on Edmonton Centres, entitled "Seniors Centres of the Future": Report (1) Final Research Report, and (2) Public Consultation Report. I will place these two reports in our library for member reading, and at the coffee table by our TV lounge. You can also read the reports on-line at:

One table that jumped out at me, is highlighted below.



This table illustrates why seniors in Edmonton visit their Centre(s). Unfortunately, the only province-wide system that funds seniors centres, known as FCSS (Family & Community Support Services) does not support funding of recreation and socialization programs for seniors. Yet recreation and socialization reduces seniors isolation; contributes to active aging, good health, wellness, and longevity of life. Like in Edmonton, it is a major reason why people visit our Centre. The constraint in allowable funding limits our Centre's financial support. These rules either need to be changed, interpreted differently for seniors; or a reallocation of health funds needs to be made provincially to support a second program that addresses what FCSS will not support. Please give our MLA's and civic leaders this message.

On another topic. Nord-Bridge recently modified our member data base so we can easily track where members live, for example north, south, or west Lethbridge. Membership sales are currently up 5% above the same date last year. I will provide more details on member stats in a future Newsletter. In the meantime, thanks for inviting your friends to join you at Nord-Bridge.



We had an impressive turnout at our St. Patrick's Day Celebration last month. Over 120 members and invited guests attended the event and enjoyed three hours of Irish music performed by John King. The success of the event combined with the positive comments and feedback received, ensures that we'll make this an annual event at Nord-Bridge. Thanks to everyone who helped.

SCAM ALERT: Unfortunately, last month one of our members fell victim to a scam and asked that I share some information so others would not be scammed. The member was looking to update the antivirus software on their computer and found a toll free number on a website. The member initiated a phone call and spoke with a support service representative who sold them a product that was not required. The member gave the scammers remote access onto their computer where they gained full access to the member's computer files, programs and possibly loaded malicious software that could steal personal and financial information. The member paid the scammers an amount with their credit card and when they looked at their statement they noticed the amount was much more than expected, and taken out in US funds. The member immediately contacted their credit card company and they were able to reverse the charge. I want to make sure everyone knows they should never give anyone remote access onto their computer to install any software. Giving someone remote access onto your computer is like giving someone a key to your home. Scammers are becoming more clever in disguising their identities. The E-mail addresses look like they are coming from trusted sources; telephone numbers on call displays appear to be legitimate numbers. However, don't be fooled and don't be forced into something over the phone or at your doorstep. There is nothing that requires you to take immediate action. The next time a scammer contacts you; or a pop up shows up on your computer, do not take any action that allows them further access onto your computer. Do not provide them any personal or financial information. Terminate the contact as soon as possible. Feel free to come and chat with me if you have experienced any fraudulent communications with scammers.
