#### EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

### Greetings Members,

In May I looked at the statistics for this year's CVITP (Canadian Volunteer Income Tax Program). This is the service delivered by our Seniors Helping Seniors office March - April, where senior citizen volunteers help other seniors, **and the community at large** with filing Income Tax Returns. I am pleased to report that Harry



and his team met with and helped 1,347 individuals with their annual filing requirements. To support our requests for government funding, we also started tracking some relevant information on who was using the service, etc. We did this on a separate questionnaire the preparers filled out after their consultation, thus ensuring complete anonymity for the client. Here are some statistics that might be of interest to you:

- **Type of service rendered**: 96.7% of those assisted were filing current year returns; 4.2% previous year returns.
- Client profile: 60.3% of our "single" clients, and 23.6% of our "couple" returns were for individuals under the Alberta Government Special Needs program threshold meaning that most of our clientele are in lower income brackets.
- Clientele referred to Nord-Bridge by a friend: 77.8%.
- Client age: 65+ years 68.3%; 55-64 yrs 13.1%; 35-54 yrs 10.2%; 34 and under 8.5%.
- Place of residence: 82.8% were from Lethbridge.
- Members of Nord-Bridge: only 22.6%.

What these statistics say is that our team of nine CVITP / Seniors Helping Seniors Program volunteers have helped a large sector of our community, and in particular many outside of the Nord-Bridge family, with important tax preparation and form completion services. A special thanks goes out to Harry, Sheila, Beverly, Shirley T, Ruth, Lilia, Margaret, Shirley H and Vicki for their dedicated and skilled volunteer services to Lethbridge and area citizenry.

While our CVITP Program is completed for the year, our Seniors Helping Seniors office will remain open on a reduced hours schedule. If you need help with non-filed taxes, CPP, OAS, or Alberta Subsidy programs for Alberta Seniors, call us at 403-329-3222 on Wednesday mornings, or any other time, to make an appointment.

I wish all members an enjoyable and safe summer.






