# LORRI'S CORNER

Over the past few weeks I have been asked by quite a few people what empowerment means. This is in response to the exciting 55+ women's conference being held at Nord-Bridge on Saturday June 10, 2017 "Empowering Wellness in Women".



Empowerment involves investing in oneself creating confidence, building strength and knowledge to achieve one's full potential. Everyone has strengths and weaknesses and a range of skills that are used in everyday situations, but all too often people remain unaware of, or undervalue, their true abilities. Basically, empowerment means to become powerful.

- 6. You have a vision for your life and know what you stand for. You want to leave a legacy of strength and what you care about.
- 7. You feel supported to achieve all you can be. You recognize that we all need help sometimes and you are surrounded by a nurturing community that provides opportunity to learn and grow.

During the conference we hope those in attendance will recognize the strengths they already have and also develop skills or gain knowledge that will enhance these skills.



#### EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Greetings Members,

On May 16 Nord-Bridge will be holding its annual Life Member Recognition Luncheon. This is when the Association pays tribute to long-term members selected by the Board for this "Special Recognition Status." The practice of naming Life Members of the Association goes back to our earliest history, when Nord-Bridge was incorpo-

rated as a society in 1980, now thirty-seven (37) years ago. The early By-Laws basically read: "There shall be four (4) categories of membership in Nord-Bridge", including: General Member individuals age 55 and over; Associate Member— individuals under age 55 whose spouse is a member, or who is approved for Associate Membership by the Board for special cause; Honorary Members — who are so identified by the Board for political niceties (which in most of our history has seldom happened); and Life Members - individuals who have reached defined ages; have been members for a certain number of years, and who have been active volunteers with Nord-Bridge. The Board of Directors reviews a list of potential Life Member candidates each December / January / February, and approves recipients of Life Membership, announcing the names once per year at the Association's March Annual General Meeting. The criteria for Life Membership "special recognition status" is contained in the [2009] By-Laws, and currently reads:

- An individual must be a minimum of 80 years of age, having been an active volunteer where possible, and a supportive [paid] member of Nord-Bridge for a minimum of ten (10) years in total. Thus the member:
  - Must have already passed their 80th birthday by the March Annual General Meeting.
  - Must have paid their Association membership in the year Life Membership is awarded.
  - Must have been an active volunteer with the Association, which is interpreted to mean not just a participant in a program or activity. The individual needs to have served a recognizable length of time as a Convener, program organizer, or volunteer like in the kitchen or serving. in the Craft Boutique, at the Reception Desk, on the Board or a standing committee, or contributed to a significant administrative function.
- An individual must have reached 90 years of age, and been a paid member of Nord-Bridge for a minimum of three (3) years in total. Thus the member:
  - Must have already passed their 90<sup>th</sup> birthday by the March Annual General Meeting.
  - Must have paid their Association membership in the year Life Membership is awarded.

Annual membership fees are waived after Life Membership is awarded. The names of Life Members are permanently recorded on plaques prominently displayed in the Nord-Bridge Seniors Centre. Please see these plagues in the hallway leading to the Dunford Diner Annex. Currently, there are 100 living Life Members of the Nord-Bridge Senior Citizens Association. Of these, about 72 individuals are still healthy and active participants at Nord-Bridge. Another 18 reside in Lethbridge, but live at care facilities because of health issues. We sometimes see these Life Members at monthly Outreach Programs. Finally, 10 have moved from Lethbridge to live closer to family. Should you feel that you would like to qualify for Life Membership "special recognition status", please speak with myself or Kathy Filkowski, who maintains Membership records, to review this possibility.
