

Greetings Members,

One of the most significant events which will impact all senior citizens and the broader City as well, will be the **Municipal Election on October 16**. Of course, we encourage all citizens to use their democratic privilege, to vote for those you feel best com-



mitted and capable of governing our community. With elections only occurring every four years, decisions of seniors can significantly impact their future. Your vote also does much to say what kind of community you leave your children, and our society in general. 
