



LORRI'S CORNER

Most of us deal with grieving experiences on a regular basis and never realize it. While most associate grief with death, it's something that reaches far beyond that narrow focus. Grief is the normal and natural



reaction to every change we experience in life. Many of those changes are so small that, while we have feelings attached to those events, we don't usually label them as grief.

We learn at a very young age to bury our emotional pain, taught by our parents, because that

is what they were taught.

Think back to an early loss that made you cry, perhaps a lost toy or balloon or a beloved pet. You were probably told, "Don't feel bad" then may have been told "We will get you a new one". When you were told to not feel bad... did you feel better? Perhaps you felt a little better if the item or pet was quickly replaced, but in those first moments I am quessing you probably still felt sad.

That discounted grief you felt in those first moments helped set the stage for how you would deal with grief and loss for the rest of your life.

With the many other losses that happen in life, you've probably heard those same words many times. The message received was that showing feelings of sadness was not the right thing to do so you stuffed those feelings inside.

Comments such as these are an attempt to help by trying to offer a "logical" suggestion to make the person feel better. This offers little solace and comfort however.

Grievers have broken hearts, not broken heads.

Are you ready to learn a new way to grieve losses in your life and heal your heart from past losses? I will be offering the **8 week Grief Recovery program again starting on February 28, 2019**. This is *not* a support group, but an action based program that will show you the necessary steps to deal with your emotional pain.

Through the work over the 8 weeks, you will be able to recall the fond memories without being overwhelmed by the emotional pain. It's not about forgetting, but rather identifying the *unfinished business* in your relationship: the things that you might have wished had been different, better or more. I invite you to come chat with me about this My February schedule: program.



LEARN - Lethbridge Elder Abuse Response Network.



Hi! My name is **Joanne Blinco**, I am the **LEARN** Case Manager which I started in June of 2016.

I wanted to share with you a bit of my background and who I am. I was born and raised in the farming community of Humboldt Saskatchewan. My husband Jeff and I then moved to

Lethbridge where we raised our three boys who also have made Lethbridge their home. We are blessed to have two wonderful grandchildren.

My work history has been with the provincial government in the Children and Family Services Ministry. I have had the opportunity to do family support, intakes, investigation and case management in all communities in southern Alberta. I have had a very rewarding career thus far. However, I was feeling that I wanted to explore another passion and that was to work and learn with seniors. My door is always open to support those who unfortunately might be in the following defined positions;

Elder abuse is any action or inaction by self or others that jeopardizes the health or well being of an older adult. Elder abuse can take several forms including financial, emotional, physical, sexual, medication and neglect, with more than one type of abuse often occurring at the same time. Elder abuse can include the infliction of physical injury, restraint, financial exploitation, threats, ridicule, insult or humiliation, withholding medication, unwanted touching or sexual contact, forced isolation (physical or social), or forced change in living arrangements. It may also include neglect, which is defined as the refusal or failure to care for an older person. This could include abandonment, withholding or not providing food, healthcare, companionship or assistance.

Any senior can become a victim of elder abuse regardless of gender, race, ethnicity, income or education. Like other types of family violence, the dynamics of elder abuse are complex. Elder abuse is often committed by someone known to the victim, such as a family member, friend, neighbor or caregiver. Abusers can also include any individual in a position of power, trust or authority. If you, or someone you know is experiencing abuse, please give me a call. When it comes to Elder Abuse, silence is not an option. I can be reached at 403 394-0306.
