

#### LORRI'S CORNER

It is that time of year where door to door sales people are out in full force. They arrive using high-pressure sales tactics convincing you to buy something you don't want or need, or they talk you into renovations or work on your home. They can resort to scare tactics making you believe your safety could be in jeopardy.



If a sales person shows up at your

door or phones, ask yourself the following 3 questions:

- Is what they are selling an item or appliance you feel needs to be replaced, repaired or something you need to own?
- 2. Prior to them showing up or phoning had you considered or been checking into the costs related to this?
- 3. Have you sought out a reputable business in the city regarding the product or service?

These questions, while not a guarantee, will give you time to think about what they are selling and if you do need it.

You have a right to not answer your door if you suspect it is a sales person and it isn't rude to ignore them. If you do choose to speak to them, here are a few suggestions.

- Ask for photo ID: get the name of the person and the business **BUT** Remember that ID's can also be
- Ask to see their city business license
- Never share personal information (For example, an electricity or gas bill)
- If you ask a salesperson to leave, they must leave right away. If you feel unsafe, call local police
- Do not rely on a salesperson's opinion that your item is unsafe or should be replaced, contact another company to come inspect it.
- Local utility companies, municipalities, government agencies or regulatory organizations don't send salespeople door-to-door
- You do not have to sign a contract at that time. Limited time offers or that they are only in the area for a short period of time are red flags.
- Before hiring someone ask for references and check them

My personal rule – one I adhere to without exception – is that if I didn't call their company to my home for a consultation, then I am not talking to them. I will not show any

#### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

Greetings Members,

June not only marks the half way point for 2019; but also a good checkpoint to see where we sit leading up to the year end. I am very pleased to report to our membership a few highlights from our first six months of 2019. In terms of membership numbers we have (at the time of writing this



article) 1,319 paid for 2019. That is 108 members away from surpassing our 2018 membership count. If you haven't already done so, bring a friend or neighbor to Nord-Bridge for a coffee and show them what a "Friendly" place we have here. Even if they don't purchase a membership; at least they will have been introduced to Nord-Bridge for a future date. A few months ago, I mentioned in my report that our Dunford Diner was the best kept secret in Lethbridge. Well numbers don't lie; food sales are already up \$7,500 year to date from 2018. Our liver and onions and veal cutlet lunch specials seem to draw the crowds (last month we served over 90 liver and onions over the lunch hour). I know liver and onions is not everyone's cup of tea, however, 90+ plates served sure demonstrates its popularity. I've heard comments from community members saying they mark it each month in their calendar for our liver and veal days. \*Note: liver and onions day in June is the 21st. Fitness 55 Club and general programming revenues are also well ahead of last years figures by \$1,000 and \$9,000 respectively. The Fitness 55 Club has seen over a dozen new members join over the last month; which would account for the \$1,000 increase from the 2018 figures. A \$9,000 jump in general programming can be directly related to the additional programs Ashley has planned and implemented. Ashley has done a fantastic job implementing new programs that attract new and current members' programming needs. Great Job Ashley!

Last month (May 9th) Board President Bob Tarleck and myself were invited to the Community Foundation of Lethbridge and Southwestern Alberta Spring 2019 Community Priorities Grant celebrations. Nord-Bridge's grant application for boardroom chair replacements was successful. The Community Foundation granted \$5,000 to our boardroom chair replacement project. The current boardroom chairs were over 18 years old and showing signs of their age. Nord-Bridge expresses our appreciation to the Community Foundation for the grant.


