Nord-Bridge also used the luncheon as an opportunity to unveil two paintings local artist and Nord-Bridge member Jerry Arnold donated. The paintings, "Days Gone By" and "Weekend Retreat", depict Alberta scenes that have personal meaning to Jerry. They are now on display in our hallway. We also welcomed Lethbridge East MLA, Nathan Neudorf, who brought greetings from the Province.

#### Nord-Bridge Follows City Transit Recommendations That Could Impact Seniors

Nord-Bridge typically tracks federal, provincial, and municipal policy discussions that could affect seniors. The discussion in City Hall about possible changes to how Lethbridge Transit meets the needs of seniors is an example of this.

As a cost-saving measure, the City is considering a reduction in transit service to some Lethbridge routes, including some servicing North Lethbridge during off-rush -hour-periods. If implemented, that change could have important consequences for some of our members. First, it could pose a problem for seniors attempting to schedule medical, dental or professional appointments, or to do grocery shopping. And second, seniors who re-schedule appointments to meet rush-hour transit schedules may find it difficult to find a seat on over-crowded buses. Nord-Bridge will attempt to obtain more information about this proposal.




