EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Growing up in a small Southern Alberta town (Nobleford, AB), I had the opportunity to spend time with a lot of world war veterans who would have coffee at my parent's restaurant. I heard many courageous stories of those who served and made significant contributions to our



country. I fondly remember the community veterans who shared these stories with me and how they returned home to our community to farm or work in the factory. I am forever grateful to have heard these stories firsthand and to have met these veterans who served to make Canada and the world a better place to live.

Last month, Nord-Bridge was one of 19 community groups that presented to the Economic Standing Policy Committee requesting fee for services /operational funding for one-time allocation or ongoing. With Vice-President Helen Gepneris, I presented to the ESPC how our revenue through gaming and programming was severely impacted by the worldwide pandemic and how our operating expenses continue to steadily increase each year by 3%. Nord-Bridge requested ongoing funding for 2023 – 2026 of \$75,000 for each year to assist with operational expenses. Our request has been referred to the ESPC 2023-2026 Operating Budget Deliberations that will be held mid-November. We're hoping for a positive outcome.

Last month we were also informed that our 2023 FCSS contract budget would be reduced by almost \$20,000. One of the reasons for the reduction; FCSS funding cannot be carried over into 2023 due to the conclusion and reissuance of the current funding agreement between the City of Lethbridge and the Government of Alberta ending December 31, 2022. In total 5 other organization's contracts were reduced for a combined total of \$331,677.87. How does the reduction affect Nord-Bridge? Mostly, wages and some program delivery are impacted through the reduction. We can assure all members that programs will not be interrupted as we will supplement the reduction of contract dollars to continue our social inclusion programs.

Price increase notice. Due to increasing food costs we must increase prices in our Dunford Diner. Please note that as of the 1st of November 2022 there will be small price increases to many of the menu items. Our new menu prices are listed on page 9 of the Newsletter. We greatly appreciate your understanding on this matter and your continued **David Ng** support. Thank you.

Lethbridge Elder Abuse Response Network: November is Family Violence Prevention Month, which includes elder abuse! Did you know Alberta has the third highest rate of self-reported spousal violence among Canadian provinces? Yet, family violence is preventable. You can recognize the significance of family violence prevention and increase your knowledge on the topic by wearing purple and attending webinars/events locally or online.

A resource that comes to mind is the Safer Spaces Certificate offered by the Alberta Government. The Safer Spaces Certificate is embedded within The Residential Tenancies Act and allows for victims of family violence to end a lease agreement, without financial penalty. More information can be found at https://www.alberta.ca/safer-spaces-

certificate.aspx. Additionally, individuals can apply for an Alberta Works grant for fleeing family violence which can be used for moving costs, or emergency shelter costs.

Join us in recognizing Family Violence Month by wearing a purple ribbon in support of ending family violence and promoting local resources that can help, such as those named above.

The colour purple became associated with family violence after women fought for equal rights in the United States, and those who marched in rallies chose to wear purple to make a visual impact. Also, the US Military awards a purple heart to those who have been wounded in service. It is widely maintained that for the above reasons, among others. survivors of family violence have suffered emotional and/or physical injury as a result, and the colour is meant to be a symbol of peace, courage, survival, honour, and dedication to ending violence. To learn more about elder abuse specifically, you can book a LEARN presentation for your agency/ business. If you would like to collect resources on elder abuse, I always have some on hand in my office on the second floor of LSCO and am happy to provide them to you!


