#### At Minds in Motion® you will...

- · Stay physically active
- · Meet and socialize with others living with dementia and care partners
- · Get involved in activities such as board or word games, bingo, and other cognitive games
- · Have access to information about dementia and support, as needed

#### Is Minds in Motion® for me?

Minds in Motion is designed for people with early to mid-stage symptoms of Alzheimer's disease or another dementia. Symptoms may include memory loss, confusion What you need to communication difficulties, and changes in mood and behavior.

Minds in Motion is intended to be enjoyed with a friend, family member, or care partner. Being virtual, the person living with dementia and the care partner need to be in a cohort and able to participate in the same room together during the program sessions, to support one another.

#### What can I expect?

The 2-hour program is divided into the following two components:

- 1. The class starts with a certified fitness instructor leading a low impact fitness class.
- 2. For the second part of the program, trained facilitators engage participants in social and cognitive activities
