I was blessed to be able to spend time with my family over the holidays and enjoy laughs, food and some Christmas cheer. I hope all our members were able to enjoy



time with friends and loved ones over the holiday season.

December flew by for us at Nord-Bridge with all the events that were planned. Our Christmas Winter Wonderland was a tremendous success this year with over 200 people attending and bringing non-perishable food items for the Interfaith Food Bank Society of Lethbridge. In total, 627 pounds of non -perishables were collected from this event. Interfaith Food Bank informed us the food collected is valued at \$2207 and helped support many individuals and families in need over the holidays. We were also able to donate 22 fully decorated trees to the Food Bank who distributed them to families. A big thank you to Ashley, Melanie, staff and volunteers for arranging such a great event which brought such a festive atmosphere to our building.

Last month, we also planned a Christmas Light Tour with the hopes of filling two of our shuttle busses. Mike Mikado from Mikado Electric kindly offered to sponsor this event which allowed us the ability to offer the event free of charge. A week prior to the event, one of our shuttle busses was shut down for maintenance and forced us to cancel 16 registered

for the light tour. Fortunately, we were able to contact Tim Davis from Davis Auto Group, who generously offered one of their shuttle busses and a driver to step in and transport our members around the city to view all the colorful



Christmas lights. Please join me and thank these two community businesses, Mikado Electric and Davis Auto Group.



Wellness Tips for Seniors during the Winter

<u>Bundle Up</u>

Seniors struggle with regulating their body temperature. This can put a senior at risk for getting hypothermic in cold weather. The thermostat should be kept at a comfortable temperature, like 68°F (20°C). It's a good idea for a senior to wear layered clothing outdoors so their body retains the heat. Seniors should wear a hat on their head and gloves to keep their hands warm. The wind tends to blow in Southern Alberta and protection is needed.

Stay Hydrated

Cold air and indoor heaters can cause dehydration in seniors. Try to encourage a senior to drink plenty of water and use moisturizers to avoid dry skin. Did you know that plants in the house give off moisture and can make a senior's day brighter?

Eat Well

A senior should eat fruits and vegetables and whole grains or follow Canada's food guidelines to get daily nutrition. Following the food guide will help a senior with digestion and may assist with lower cholesterol and blood sugars. A bowl of homemade soup from the Nord-Bridge Dunford Diner will boost a senior's well-being.

Exercise

It is important for a senior to have a strong body and a positive mind. Seniors should try to get plenty of sunshine as the sun is a great source of vitamin D, which strengthens bones. Melanie Hillaby can offer great workout classes at Nord Bridge. Classes offered in the Winter session include chair yoga, cardio/strength/yoga, walking club and Pilates. Attending a fitness class is a great way to help stretch, strengthen muscles, promote relaxation, and improve cardiac health and large motor skills.

Stay Connected

If you know a senior who is living at home by themselves, try and have someone check in on them periodically. This can be face-to-face or on a Zoom call. Popular board or card games are fun activities that encourage socializing and bonding. Card games such Canasta and Bridge are played in the dining room at Nord Bridge and anyone can join!


