EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

I hope I don't jinx us for the month of September, but I am very pleased to say this summer I wasn't pestered by millions of mosquitoes and wasps. Each summer, I feel we're actively swatting and dodging the mosquitoes and wasps that are circling around us; however this



summer I don't recall feeling under attack by the pesky flying vampires and stingers! This has made sitting outside on the patio and golfing much more enjoyable.

Programming will kick off in the first few weeks of September which will start driving people back into Nord-Bridge. We will start to see more traffic in the building and the parking lot. As we get busier, this is a friendly reminder about parking. Please refrain from parking in front of the storefront tenants' parking spaces. These stores include The Medicine Shoppe, Chinook LifeCare, Salon Nineteen04, Savers Convenience Store and Savers Liquor Store. Also, many members are parking along the surrounding residential streets when the parking lot is full. For those who are parking along the street, please ensure that you are not blocking the driveways of the residential houses. We have received a few phone calls from houses in our neighborhood advising us their driveways have been blocked by parked vehicles of those attending Nord-Bridge.

If you're looking to avoid the hassle of driving and finding a parking space at Nord-Bridge, consider taking the Go Friendly Shuttle service. The Go Friendly is a door-to-door pickup and drop off service where the shuttle will pick passengers up from their homes and drop them off directly at either Nord-Bridge or LSCO. The service is based on scheduled pickup and drop off times, where we try to accommodate passengers' requirements as best we can. The Go Friendly is a great option for those who don't have access to any other forms of transportation, or to those looking for transportation options. We have many riders who still drive their own vehicles during the spring, summer and fall months but opt to ride the Go Friendly during the icy and snowy winter months. 
The following are the benefits of lifelong learning:

- Seniors that are lifelong learners feel a part of something bigger





Programmer's Report




It's hard to believe the summer months are now behind us! I got a chance to get outside for walks in the coulees - here are some photos of one foggy morning in early August.




