EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Just a quick follow up from my article last month; I completely jinxed us! No sooner had I submitted my September newsletter article, was I swarmed by wasps outside around my neighborhood. I have learned my lesson and will not underestimate those pesky wasps again.



Last month we completed a small renovation project at our front reception desk. If you haven't noticed, we've added two new windows in the office directly across from the front reception desk. This renovation was much needed to accommodate the busy front reception area. As many of you know our little centre is growing and becoming busier everywhere, mostly in the dining room, registered programs, parking lot and the front desk. The front



desk layout will currently accommodate two to three staff and volunteers to service members and guests. As we have steadily grown over the last three years we have experienced more challenges with a log jam of people at the front desk; someone taking cash, another person registering a member for classes, someone receiving a phone call and then one more person greeting members and guests as they sign in. All this traffic at times feels like a subway station in downtown New York. By shifting a staff member to the new office, we will be able to relieve some of the congestion and traffic at the front desk. Please keep in mind this will not solve the problem completely but it will enhance our ability to serve members and guests more efficiently.

Last month Board Secretary Anne Pauls resigned from the executive after 8 years. As per our by-laws we filled the vacant secretary position with Board Member Judy Cartwright, and Anne moved into fill Judy's remaining 7 month term as a third year director. Anne, thank you so much for your years of dedication to our board and executive. I've appreciated working with you for the past 8 years since I became the Executive Director.







to fit in two amazing travel adventures during all this FUN!





Lethbridge Elder Abuse Response Network

Have you heard of Week Without Violence? The Week Without Violence is a global movement among YWCAs across the country and around the world to end violence against women and girls. YWCA is a part of the LEARN Coordinated Community Response Network. They share the values and goals of LEARN, as we all work towards a world without genderbased violence, including elder abuse. Although this seems like a steep goal, we firmly believe family and domestic violence are completely preventable.

Not all violence is acknowledged or responded to equally. For more than 20 years, YWCAs across Canada have been setting aside one week in October to raise awareness and elevate survivor's voices. This year, Week Without Violence is from October 16-21.

The purpose is to increase public understanding that violence takes many forms and can happen anywhere, including in the home, in schools, in relationships and in the community. 
